



For many years, most medical and health-related research was done on men, and it was assumed that women have the same health problems and needs. We now realize that this is not true. The symptoms and progression of diseases differ between men and women. Men and women have unique needs due to their unique physiology, and each may benefit from different health strategies. One concern unique to men revolves around the prostate.

As men age, their prostate often changes. It may become enlarged or inflamed, which may result in a variety of difficulties with urination.

You can do a number of things to help maintain prostate health. Drink water. Avoid caffeine, alcohol, and spicy foods. Watch your weight. Exercise. And use supplements. One unique supplement to maintain prostate health is pollen extracts.

"But the truth is the anti-inflammatory effect, the antioxidant effect, the smooth muscle-relaxing effect of the flower pollen extracts are extremely important as part of their influence on the prostate. And so, what



you're looking at is an item that either has only one mode of action, the saw palmetto, or a compound, the flower pollen extracts, which have at least three modes of action. This is how I would compare the two different items. It's not that saw palmetto is bad, I think the flower pollen extracts are better."

AIM ReAssure® is a unique product that capitalizes on the power of pollen extracts. It is an excellent supplement to support overall health and prostate health as men age.

The pollen in AIM ReAssure® is largely gathered from the rye plant. Specially cultivated fields in Sweden are carefully monitored. Air surveillance is often used to determine the best time to harvest the pollen. Once this is done, meshes are moved through the fields to trap the pollen.

From here, a proprietary method is used to extract active substances from the rye pollen. It takes about 10,000 plant tops to produce one kg (2.2 lb) of pollen extracts.

How to use AIM ReAssure®

- Take 1 to 2 tablets at breakfast and dinner. You may take more or less, depending on your needs. Most users start with 2 tablets at breakfast and dinner and, after experiencing the desired results, use 1 tablet at breakfast and dinner for maintenance.
- Close tightly after opening and store in cool, dry, dark place (70-75 °F; 20.1-23.8 °C). Do not refrigerate.

Saw palmetto, often combined with zinc, is sometimes used for prostate health. Saw palmetto affects men's health through one mechanism, while pollen extracts work through three mechanisms. Thus, pollen extracts are more efficient, often producing desired benefits in a shorter period of time than saw palmetto.

How else can I help my prostate?

Prostate health can be affected by nutrition. Drinking adequate water and avoiding caffeine, alcohol, and spicy foods can help, as does nutritional supplementation. The powerful antioxidant properties of the mineral selenium and the vitamins A (beta carotene), C, and E may be instrumental in protecting the prostate gland. AIM Proancynol® 2000 contains selenium; AIM BarleyLife® contains the vitamins A, C, and E; AIM Just Carrots® contains vitamin A; and AIM CellSparc 360® contains tocotrienols, a form of vitamin E. The carotenoid lycopene, also in AIM Proancynol® 2000, has been shown to be a more potent inhibitor of human cancer cells than all other carotenoids.

Enlarged prostate tissue contains elevated levels of cholesterol and its metabolites, so it is advisable to watch cholesterol levels. Selenium may also be helpful in this regard because it has been shown to increase HDL cholesterol levels. Cultures that consume high-fat, high-sugar diets have higher rates of prostate problems; so a low-fat, low-sugar diet is recommended.

Finally, moderate exercise, such as walking, can be helpful, as can hydrotherapy: sitting in a hot bath for 15 to 20 minutes. Consider adding AIM Cell Wellness Restorer® for a relaxed, rejuvenated feeling.
